

Lecturers 教学师资

Professor Liming Wang, Director of UCD Irish Institute for Chinese Studies

Professor Liming Wang completed an International MBA at Sheffield Hallam University in 1989 and later earned a PhD in Economics from Queen's University Belfast, where he became a teaching and research fellow in 1995. From 2000, he served as Senior Research Fellow and Head of the China Unit, managing Queen's collaborations with China. In 2006, Prof. Wang established the Irish Institute for Chinese Studies at UCD and is the Founding Director of the UCD Confucius Institute for Ireland. He holds leadership roles in academic and professional organizations, including the Secretary General of the Chinese Economic Association in Europe and the President of the Academic Committee of the Global Lecture Series on Chinese Economy. His research focuses on Chinese economy, development and energy economics, financial contagion, and agricultural economics.

Dr Caitríona Osborne, Assistant Professor at UCD Irish Institute for Chinese Studies

Dr Caitríona Osborne teaches Chinese language and Chinese Teaching Methodology at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels. She earned her PhD from Dublin City University in 2020, focusing on teaching methods for Chinese character acquisition. Caitríona is Secretary General of the Irish Association of Chinese Teaching and a member of the Irish Association for Applied Linguistics and the European Association of Chinese Studies. Her research interests include Chinese language education, pedagogy, and translation.

Professor Alessandro Benati, Head of UCD School of Education

Professor Alessandro Benati is a leading expert in second language acquisition, renowned for his research in processing instruction and the effects of focus on form across various languages. His innovative studies, including the use of online measurements like eye tracking, have significantly advanced the field. He became a full professor in the UK in 2012 and has held prominent roles at institutions such as the University of Portsmouth, University of Greenwich, University of Hong Kong, and the University of Sharjah. He is also the co-author of several influential books and articles, published in top journals, and his research has been recognized as internationally excellent.

Dr Huichao Xie, UCD School of Education

Dr Huichao Xie is an Assistant Professor in Education at University College Dublin researching and teaching on early childhood special and inclusive education. Huichao received her Ph.D. in Special Education with an expertise in early intervention/early childhood special education from the University of Oregon in Eugene, Oregon, United States. Before joining UCD, Huichao served as an Assistant Professor at the National Institute of Education of Nanyang Technological University in Singapore, where she was the Principal Investigator in three grant projects and received a Research Excellence Award in 2022.

Dr Anna Nunan, Head of Unit at the UCD Centre for English and Global Languages

Dr Nunan is the lead on the Centre's Global Language Modules Programme, In-sessional English modules and the Masters degree in the Teaching of English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL). She works on the development of quality language programmes across a broad range of languages and levels at UCD. She also focuses on the area of English for Academic Purposes for international students, and lectures in the areas of methodology and language assessment on the Masters in TESOL. Her research interests are plurilingualism, language teaching methodologies and language testing.

Dr Alex Runchman, UCD Centre for English and Global Languages

Since 2018, Dr Alex Runchman has led the development and academic coordination of English for Academic Purposes modules across UCD's partnership programmes in China. He also lectures on UCD's MA in TESOL and developed the Professional Certificate in TESOL. He graduated with an MA in English Language and Literature at University of Oxford and MPhil in American Literature at University of Cambridge and gained his PhD in American Literature from Trinity College Dublin in 2012. His primary area of interest is English for Academic Purposes (EAP), with a focus on teacher training in Transnational Education, Education for Sustainable Development, assessment, international students' transition from IELTS to Academic English, Global Englishes, and the teaching of academic listening and writing.
